5. Open Forum

- I. Insurance was changed, a packet was sent out regarding the new company and details. The wind and hail deductible is 5%; we tried to lower it but were unable. The other companies we got quotes from raised their rates, and wind & hail insurance at 5% is becoming very common. Homeowners are recommended to get an HO6 policy. Landlords should have a business policy. Renters should have renters' insurance to cover their belongings.
- II. Lots of unsavory characters roaming around the property. 2 bicycles have been stolen, 1 car has been jimmied, 1 car stolen, and one home break in, in the last year. Jesse voted to give all

- owners 30-day notice to have bike rack removed as it is inviting unwanted people in the community, all BOD in agreeance.
- III. Recycling suggested again, but we unfortunately don't have the space and can't ensure trash and recycling are kept separate due to the homeless
- IV. Suggestion made to have CenturyLink fiber installed. Ethan to contact CenturyLink for fact finding to see what CenturyLink would need in order to offer service to us.
- V. Concerns about water leaks, owners of leaking unit are responsible for paying for repairs
- VI. Electric vehicles, board needs to discuss and create policy. New law requires that EV owners be allowed to install stations.
- VII. The Board decided to cancel the November meeting and reconvene in January 2023. Date and time to be determined later.
